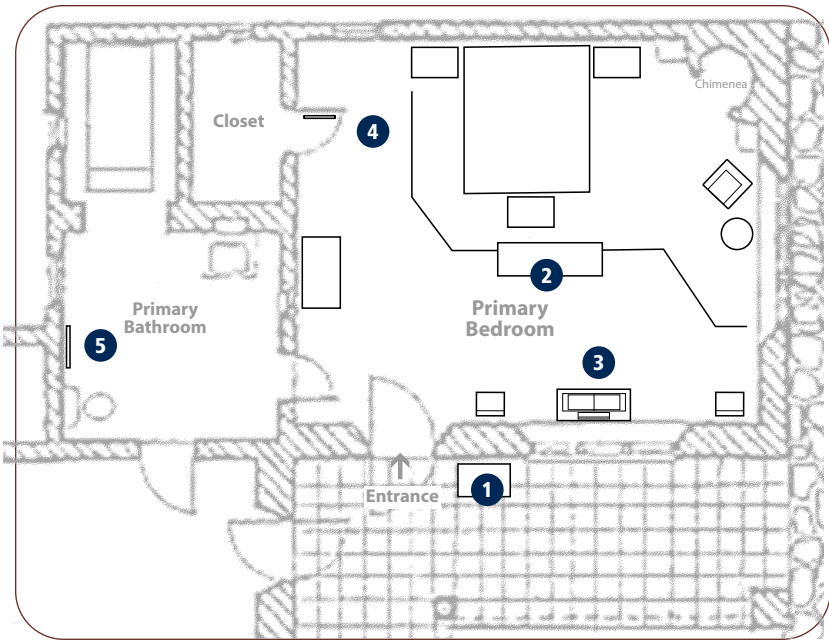

1 Leo and Deedie's Bedroom

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Leo & Deedie's Bedroom

The three-bedroom rustic adobe *hacienda* was the Carrillo family's second home in California. Their primary estate was in Santa Monica. Leo and his wife, Edith (Deedie), married in 1913. Deedie was a native of Nyack, New York. East Coast style met California *rancho* in the building of their beloved ranch retreat. Deedie died in 1953 and Leo in 1961, leaving both homes to their daughter, Tony.

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2 Haven of Rest

HAVEN OF Rest

Leo and Deedie relaxed in their bedroom after a long day of working or entertaining friends and family. Deedie decorated the room with a mix of early Victorian furniture. Her personal taste is reflected in the Victorian touches like the original four-poster bed and stoneware table lamps and dresser. Leo's influence is visible in the corner fireplace and the addition of modern amenities like this heater niche.

Original Bedroom Features

Four-poster Bed — The bed frame consists of tall posts at the head and foot, topped with a canopy or four-poster bed. The bed is made of mahogany, a material chosen for its rich, warm tones and durability.

Dresser — The mahogany dresser is an impressive, hand-crafted furniture piece in the Queen Anne style, known for its elegant curves and decorative elements.

Stoneware — The stoneware table lamps, combined with the mahogany dresser, reflect the Victorian era's emphasis on decorative and functional items.

Decorative — The Victorian-style fireplace features a tiled surround with a decorative mantel, reflecting the room's ornate and elegant aesthetic.

Heater Niche — In the spirit of the modern exhibit, this is a modern heater niche, reflecting the room's blend of historical and contemporary design.

Haven of *Rest*

Leo and Deedie relaxed in their bedroom after a long day of working or entertaining friends and family. Deedie decorated the room with a mix of early Victorian furniture. Leo's influence is visible in the corner fireplace and the addition of modern amenities like the heater niche.

Lights On!

This area saw its first electric service in 1918 and natural gas service in 1932. Leo was able to bring reliable power to the ranch, but he refused a telephone.

Original Bedroom Features

Four-poster bed – The bed frame is made of mahogany in the Sheraton style. The posts are hand-carved with acanthus leaves, a typical motif of the mid-1800s.

Stepstool – The bed is four feet high! This mahogany stepstool at the foot of the bed made it easier to get in and out.

Dresser – The mahogany clawfoot dresser in the Empire style has bookmatched burl veneer on the drawer fronts. It was a very expensive piece at the time.

Sconces – The wall lights, or sconces, combined the vintage style of a candle with the modern amenity of electricity and beauty of cut glass.

Heater niche – To the right of the wooden closet door is a recessed space built into the adobe wall to accommodate a small electric heater.

Chandelier – The Victorian-style chandelier illuminates the room with refracted light from the cut glass prisms and beads.

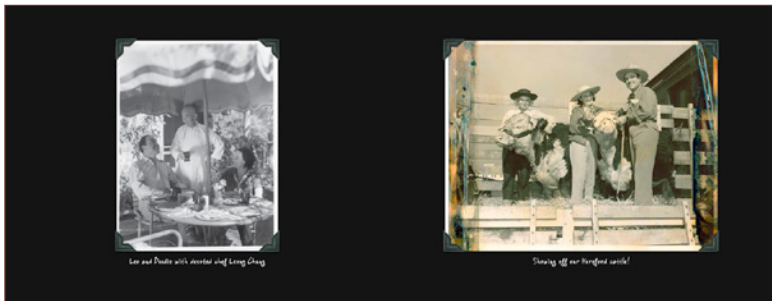

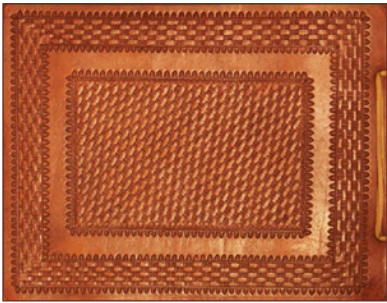

5 A Modern Bath

A Modern BATH

Contemporary ranch comforts are featured in Leo, Deedie and Tony's shared bathroom. The pink and burgundy tiles and fixtures were installed at the same time the hacienda was constructed, around 1938.



The tiles are from Gladding McBean's Hermosa Tile Division, one of the oldest pottery manufacturers in California, founded in 1875.

Original Bathroom Features

Step-down tub – An adobe brick archway leads to the step-down tub, a great place to soak after a long day working on the *rancho*.

Shower – Along with the step-down tub, the shower was progressive for the time.

Accent tiles – Several tiles around the bathroom feature a wagon design highlighting the rustic quality of the *rancho* style.

Wall heater – An electric heater built into the adobe wall warms the room for a luxury bathing experience.



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
