Annual Open Space Status Report for Fiscal Year 2018/2019

July 1, 2018 - June 30, 2019

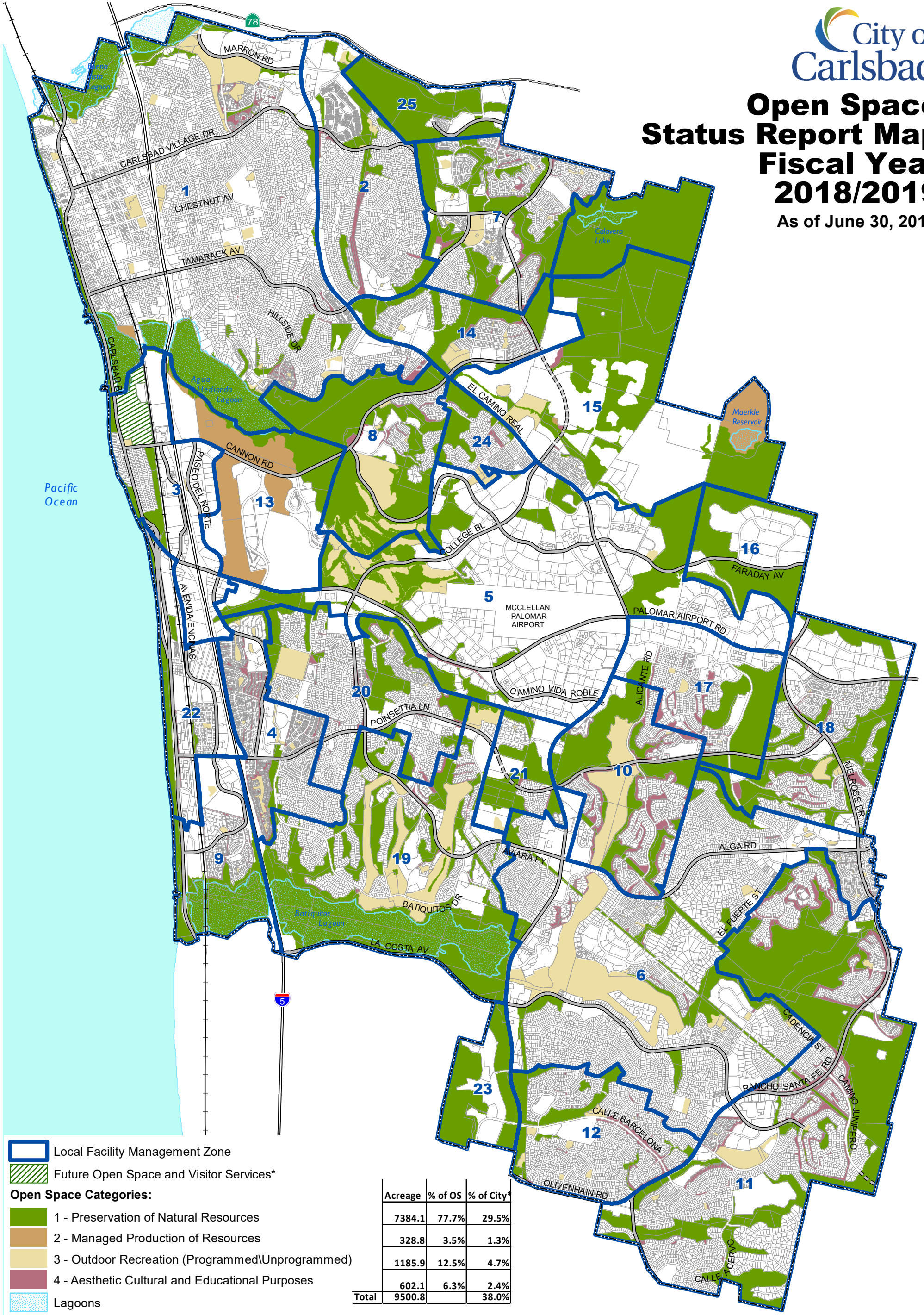
The table below shows the amount of designated open space acreage by category in each of the Local Facilities Management Zones (LFMZ). This data is current through the end of the Fiscal Year 2018/2019, ending on June 30, 2019.

Minor changes to designated open space occurred in LFMZ 1, 6, 8, 11, 19 and 20 during the fiscal year reporting period. Updated parcels from the San Diego County assessor parcel map (SanGIS) were used to rectify differences between lot lines from recorded final maps with open space easements. In connection with the Poinsettia 61 residential project and March 2017 Community Benefit Agreement, changes to Zone 8 and 19 were made to reflect the switching of open space categories from category 3 to category 1 for portions of Veterans Park and Aviara Park. In total, open space increased by 13.1 acres citywide from the previous annual report.
