CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 is a Class 1 exemption for existing facilities and includes (c) Existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities (this includes road grading for the purpose of public safety), and other alterations such as the addition of bicycle facilities, including but not limited to bicycle parking, bicycle-share facilities, and bicycle lanes, transit improvements such as bus lanes, pedestrian crossings, street trees, and other similar alterations that do not create additional automobile lanes). The improvements to the city's pedestrian lighting in the Barrio neighborhood will improve public safety. No exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 applies. Additionally, none of the limitations on using an exemption in Carlsbad Municipal Code 19.04.070 (B) apply.

For the reasons stated above, the action is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c).
