About the commission

The Traffic & Mobility Commission shall consist of seven members and will serve four year terms. The Traffic Safety & Mobility Commission Members study all matters concerning mobility and traffic safety, including implementation of the General Plan Mobility Element, and make written recommendations to the City Council and Planning Commission regarding measures that should be taken to promote mobility and traffic safety within the city. Members must be residents of Carlsbad and be registered voters. Members are required to file a "Statement of Economic Interests" with the City Clerk.

Eligibility

Members must be residents of Carlsbad and registered voters.

Meeting dates/times

Regular meetings are held in the City Council chamber the first Monday of each even month at 4 p.m.

Commissioner requirements/duties

Attend commission meetings

File an annual "Statement of Economic Interests" form

Complete ethics training and sexual harassment prevention training every two years

Appointment process

Applications are available on the city's website at www.carlsbadca.gov and in the City Clerk's Office, City Hall at 1200 Carlsbad Village Drive, Carlsbad.

The Mayor and Representatives from District 2 and District 4 shall nominate individuals to serve on the commission for a term coinciding with the term of the Council Member making the appointment.
