Effective July 1, 2020

AB 827 requires that commercial food establishments provide bins to customers for collecting organics and recycling alongside trash.

“Full-service restaurants” are exempt **as long as they provide organics and recycling bins in the back of house** for their employees. This policy works together with state laws AB 341 Mandatory Commercial Recycling and AB 1826 Mandatory Commercial Organics to maximize landfill diversion and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.



- ✓ Recycling and organic waste bins must be visible and easily accessible to customers.
- ✓ Bins must be clearly marked with labeling indicating which materials are appropriate for each bin.
- ✓ Bins must be placed adjacent to each trash can (restroom waste bins are excluded).

There is no minimum number of bins required.

It's important to Recycle Right

Keeping recyclable and compostable materials out of the trash is an excellent first step towards cost savings and improved operational efficiency. **Please contact your city, county, or hauler for more information and for signage.**
